

That to be consistent with the Constitution of this Club as amended at the 2017 Annual General Meeting, the classes of Ordinary Membership will be:

- 1) 7 day golfing member, who will be entitled to play exempt from green fees at any time on any day of the year. Formerly known as "full playing member."
- 2) Weekday golfing member, who will be entitled to play exempt from green fees at any time on any day except Saturdays and Sundays. Formerly known as "mid-week member."
- 3) Country golfing member, who will have same golfing entitlement as 7 day golfing members, but who must reside outside of the 2536 and 2537 postcodes and who must be a golfing member of some other real (i.e not virtual) Golf Australia affiliated Golf Club which is their handicap Home Club.
- 4) U35 golfing member, who will have the same golfing entitlement as 7 day golfing members, but who is aged between 23 to 35 years of age.
- 5) Intermediate golfing member, who will have same golfing entitlement as 7 day golfing members, but who is aged between 18 to 22 years of age.
- 6) Junior golfing member, who will have same golfing entitlement as 7 day golfing members, but who is under 18 years of age.
- 7) Cadet golfing member, who will have same golfing entitlement as 7 day golfing members, but who is under 18 years of age.
- 8) Social members, who will have no entitlement to exemption of green fees.
- 9) Any member holding some other pre-existing class of membership will have its duration honoured and its rights assigned to one of the classes above, at the absolute discretion of the Secretary.

All the memberships listed here include full use of the non-golfing facilities of the Club, subject to age and other considerations contained in the Club's Constitution. The Constitution defines the voting privileges of the various classes, and their entitlements regarding eligibility for the Board and rights at the Annual General Meeting. In the event of any inconsistency between this resolution and the Constitution, the Constitution will have precedence.
